

A Wax Technical Tip

Touring season is fast approaching us again, and there are times when it would be nice to wash your Model A without getting it wet! You could be driving to a show or tour and a bird decides to bomb your car, or you parked under a tree and sap dropped onto the paint. I have found a product that really works quite well for these situations. It is a product made by Armor All and is titled, *To-Go exterior detailing wipes*. These are moist little cloths that contain carnauba wax. These wipes can be used on chrome, nickel, stainless steel, and painted surfaces. They leave no streaks or sticky residue. I have used these on my Model A and they work like a champ. They are fast and easy to use. The package is designed to open and close to keep the wipes moist. I keep a pack below my seat. I can clean my entire Model A roadster pickup using two of the wipes. There are 25 of the seven by eight inch wipes in each container. They are also great for touch up when a spot was missed in the regular style washing. Carnauba wax is the wax that car museums use on the very expensive show cars. Another little side note, if you forget to seal the package or the wipes start to dry up just add a little bit of water and they are back to original condition. The cheapest place to purchase these wipes is at your local Wal-Mart where they cost \$4.29 per pack.
